**Application to Renew the Power Reactor Operating Licence for Bruce A and Bruce B
Nuclear Generating Stations**

Following a hearing on March 14, 2018 and May 28 – 31, 2018, the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC), pursuant to section 24 of the *Nuclear Safety and Control Act*,¹ renewed the Nuclear Power Reactor Operating Licence issued to Bruce Power Inc. (Bruce Power) for its Bruce Nuclear Generating Stations A and B (BNGS) located in Kincardine, Ontario. The renewed licence, PROL 18.00/2028, is valid from October 1, 2018 until September 30, 2028.

The following corrections are made to the English and French versions of the *Record of Decision* issued on September 27, 2018 by the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission.

1. On page 4 of the document, second decision box of paragraph 13, the sentence
“the Commission authorizes Bruce Power to operate the Bruce Nuclear Generating Stations A and B Units 3 – 8 up to a maximum of 300,000 equivalent full power hours;”


Erroneously refers to Units 3 – 8 and is therefore changed to

“the Commission authorizes Bruce Power to operate the **Bruce Nuclear Generating Stations A and B** up to a maximum of 300,000 equivalent full power hours;”
2. On page 40 of the document, paragraph 206, erroneously refers to Units 3 – 8. This reference is therefore removed and replaced by **Bruce NGS A and B**.
3. On page 82 of the document, paragraph 411, the sentence

“This formal arrangement should also incorporate and address the matters addressed at paragraphs 277, 288 and 319 of this record of decision as matters for collaboration.”

erroneously refers to the wrong paragraph numbers and is therefore changed to

“This formal arrangement should also incorporate and address the matters addressed at paragraphs **276, 287 and 318** of this record of decision as matters for collaboration.”
